	<p>Education.</p> <p>Applications are invited for a tenure-track faculty position at the rank of Assistant or Associate Professor in the area of Information Systems. Candidates should be technical in their teaching and research, specifically having experience in at least two of the following: security and assurance, application development, .net framework, and/or infrastructure. Applicants for the position must show evidence of quality teaching and research publications and must have the desire for and/or experience teaching at the graduate level. Applicants must have earned a doctoral degree in Information Systems. The Ph.D. must be earned <u>prior</u> to the appointment at KSU. Salary is competitive.</p> <p>KSU has established a notable record for the inclusion of minorities and women in its educational mission and strongly encourages applications from both groups.</p>
