

Instructions to presenters:

Minisymposium talks are 25 minutes, plus 5 minutes for questions.

Contributed talks are 15 minutes, plus 5 minutes for questions.

All rooms will be equipped with data projectors. Minisymposium presenters are welcome to bring their own laptop computers, but are not required to do so. Due to the shorter time for changing machines, we suggest that contributed talk presenters bring their talks on USB drives, to be prepared to be loaded onto one machine before the session begins. It will be convenient for one presenter to have a laptop to be used for all talks, so if special software is required, or videos or other difficult-to-transfer media are used, that presenter should bring a laptop. (All presenters please arrive 15 minutes before the session begins to check in with the session chair and to load your talk. If you travel with a laptop, please bring it to your session, in case it is needed.)

Instructions for posters:

Posters will be mounted on a fabric-covered board, provided at the conference. Authors can use push-pins or velcro to attach their posters, but please bring your own. **Revision: The space allocated for each poster will be 45 inches wide and 44 inches high.**

The poster session will take place Thursday, August 2, from 6-7:30pm. You will be able to set up your posters beginning at 4pm, and you should plan to take them down no later than after the banquet is over that night.

Each poster will be assigned a number, and presenters with even numbers should plan to staff their posters during the first 45 minutes (6-6:45pm), and presenters with odd numbers should plan to staff the second 45 minutes (6:45-7:30). This will allow presenters to examine the other posters.
